Parking Details

Free parking for the event is available just south of Tempe Beach Park in the 201 S

Ash Garage.

This is the ONLY FREE parking garage in Tempe on Walk day. Another option is to take the light rail to downtown Tempe.

The Mill Ave/Third Street exit on the Light Rail drops you off just one block South of Tempe Beach Park.



PLEASE NOTE: When parking in the garage, you will need to take a ticket, but parking is FREE. The exits will be open when it is time for you to leave the event. The tickets are being issued so they can count how many vehicles enter the garage.

What is the Walk to Save Animals?

The Walk to Save Animals is celebrating its 26th year as "Arizona's best attended dog walk," benefitting Arizona's oldest and largest no-kill animal shelter, the Arizona Animal Welfare League. This annual event is AAWL's largest annual fundraiser, bringing together a community of people and pets to help raise funds for thousands of vulnerable animals throughout Arizona.

Not only is the Walk to Save Animals AAWL's largest annual fundraiser, but it's also community-focused event that is full of family-friendly experiences and a variety of pet resources, from free health supplies to dog training demonstrations.

How are funds raised from the Walk used?

All funds raised at the Walk to Save Animals go directly to support AAWL's life-saving programs, including pet adoptions, behavior training, and low-cost vet care to our community.

What should I expect the day of the Walk?

This event is so much more than a 2k/5k walk! We have so many different activities and booths to check out for the whole family! Follow along at @aawlphx as we tease all the fun things we have planned for the big day.
